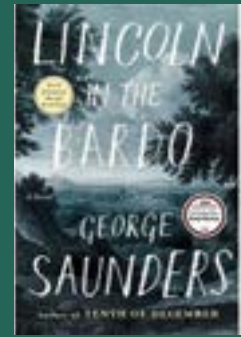
Curbside Pickup is moving!

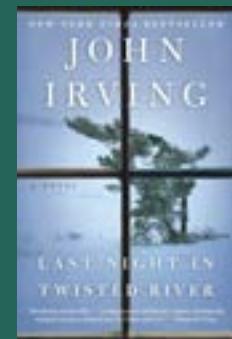
