Instructions to Make Fleece Blankets

Each blanket comprises a top piece (pattered) and a bottom piece (solid).
Blanket kit sizes are 72" x 60" or 48" x 60" (sizes have already been measured).

1. Line up the two fabric pieces on top of each other and trim them, so they are the same size.
2. Cut 4" x 4" squares from the corners using a ruler or a cardboard template. Cut through both layers of fabric at the same time.
3. Cut 4" deep strips every 1-1.5" along the fringe of the fleece. Another way to measure this is the fringe pieces should be a little wider than the width of your finger.
4. Leave your blanket flat on the surface, with all fringes lined up.
5. Tie a double knot going around the blanket with the fringes. You can tie a knot as if you are tying a shoelace. All the knots should be snug up to the blanket but not too tight. The finished blanket should lay flat.

Please return your finished blanket to any CRDL location by April 30, 2023.
